Strike Day:

The NZEI union for primary and intermediate schools, including special schools, has confirmed after a majority membership vote that a strike day will be held on Thursday 23 October.

The vote for industrial action follows the union's rejection of an offer of a pay rise for teachers between 2.7% and 4.6%, along with more issues.

Union negotiation lead Liam Rutherford said primary teachers, tumuaki / principals, school support staff and therapist staff will strike on October 23.

The decision comes after recent rolling strikes for secondary schools.

There are far more issues than just the rejection of the pay rise for the whole education sector. Here are just a few: A significant shortfall in trained teachers, a significant number leaving to teach overseas, scarce relievers for both teachers and support staff, unsustainable workloads, major curriculum restructures that are poorly resourced and implemented at speed without comprehensive consultation, as well as children arriving in school with increasingly varied and complex needs and the resources to meet those needs have not kept up.












DRC Yasumi's Class
