School will be closed Monday 26th September for the public holiday announced by the Government.

Brookfield Primary School Satellite Classes Secured: In September 2019 Minister of Education Chris Hipkins announced that due to projected student roll growth for Brookfield Primary School, the current facilities and land area was too small to accommodate the growth, so a new school would be built down the hill on Millers Road. Currently the foundations of the first part of the build are underway. What has been missing from the start was recognition that our Satellite class was on the current site and no provision was made in the design of the new school. Fast forward three years and after prolonged pressure from Brookfield's Board of Trustees and our Board, the Ministry has confirmed that we will be included in the second half of the build with a double class sized Satellite. At the beginning of next year the school's name will change to Te Kura o Manunui. The school is expected to be completed for Term 1 2024.

Many thanks to Caleb Everitt from Tauranga Boys College for the amazing sensory board and mural he designed and made for DRC. Caleb is a Year 13 student whose Year 13 Technology project brief required him to research, design and complete a project that was functional and useful for a group of people. ## **AIMS Games 2022**




























During Week 7 of this term, thousands of students from around New Zealand descended on Tauranga to compete in many different sports.
